Official Application for Star Placement in Agriculture

DESCRIPTION

To recognize annually the outstanding members of the IYFA who is working for a wage in agriculture. Any member is eligible if the principle salary earned by the individual is from a wage earning occupation. Individuals may work on a farm, in agriculture mechanics, agriculture sales or service horticulture, forestry, etc. Ownership in the area of principle wage is not considered a part of this award.

RULES OF THE AWARD

1. The Indiana Star Placement in Agriculture Award will be presented annually during the state convention of the Indiana Young Farmers' Association. Candidates may apply for only one of the following award applications in the same year: Star Leadership, Star Placement in Agriculture, Star Operation in Agriculture, or Star Improvement Project. Candidates must be present at the convention to receive the award.
2. All applicants must have paid state dues by October 1, attended three active chapter meetings during the year, had one year membership immediately preceding nomination for this award, and must be an active member during the year in which the application is made. There will be a points reduction assessed if this criteria is not met.
3. Notification will be made with a chapter official to verify qualifications of the applicant.
4. The judging committee will be selected by the Executive Director of the Indiana Young Farmers' Association. The judges will select a winner and runner-up from eligible applicants.
5. No applicant may receive the first place state award in this activity more than once every five years.
6. This application is limited to the previous three years of Young Farmer membership.
7. The application should be mailed to the Indiana Young Farmers' Association, Executive Director, Room 229, State House, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204-2798 by postmark date of November 30.

2. Current responsibilities, future goals, and background information (up to 3 pages)

- a. Give a brief summary of your family background (i.e. spouse, children, etc.) (*This question will only be used for script writing purposes; no points will be assessed.*)
- b. Describe how you became involved in the agriculture industry.
- c. Give a job description for your current position.
- d. Provide an example of a typical day in your job.
- e. Highlight an achievement within your agriculture business that you played an important role in reaching success. Give detailed information such as purpose or objective, challenges, and outcomes.
- f. Identify two short-term and two long-term goals in your occupation and what are you doing to reach each of them.

3. Leadership and Community Activities (up to 1 page)

- a. Briefly describe your Young Farmer involvement.
- b. Briefly describe your community involvement.
- c. Describe one of your most rewarding leadership experiences. Give detailed information on the purpose or objective, challenges, and outcome.

4. Photos and Captions

- a. Include at least 8 photos (can be digital)
- b. Include two-sentence captions with each photo
